Announcements

The United Methodist Church approved numerous doctrinal changes at the 2024 General Conference that we believe are not biblical. After multiple discussions and prayers regarding these changes, a majority vote of the local church body was rendered. As a result, the Clarksville First United Methodist Church will separate from the United Methodist Conference. Therefore, the church will be closing as of Sunday 12/29/2024.
